

Li Yang - One Sand, One World

Coming to us all the way from China, Li Yang will deliver a presentation and guidance on the unique techniques used in traditional Chinese Rock Color Painting.

COURSE DESCRIPTION

Join instructor Li Yang as she guides you through the intriguing process of Rock Color Painting. Rock color pigments are particles (rocks that have been ground to a powder) of different thicknesses that cannot be blended, and the desired hue is obtained through the superposition of pigments. The amazing aspect is that crystal pigments with different sizes and fine particles shine brightly under the illumination of light. Li Yang will provide the ground rocks and participants will learn how to make paintings using gelatin and alum. Additionally, attendees will learn the use, color mixing, and drawing methods of glue in Chinese Rock Color Paintings.

BIO

Li Yang, the founder of the China Academy of Mineral Color, is an advocate and disseminator of mineral color painting. Presently, she serves as a distinguished expert teaching mineral color painting courses to university students at the Sichuan University of Culture and Arts in China. Her oil paintings, acrylic paintings, and mineral color paintings have been featured in numerous exhibitions both domestically and internationally. Li Yang holds a specialized degree in Fine Arts Education from Sichuan University, a graduate level certification in Packaging and Advertising Design from the Academy of Arts & Design, Tsinghua University, and has pursued studies in the Comprehensive Painting Language Core Course at the China Central Academy of Fine Arts, as well as attended multiple painting workshops at the Li Keran Painting Institute
